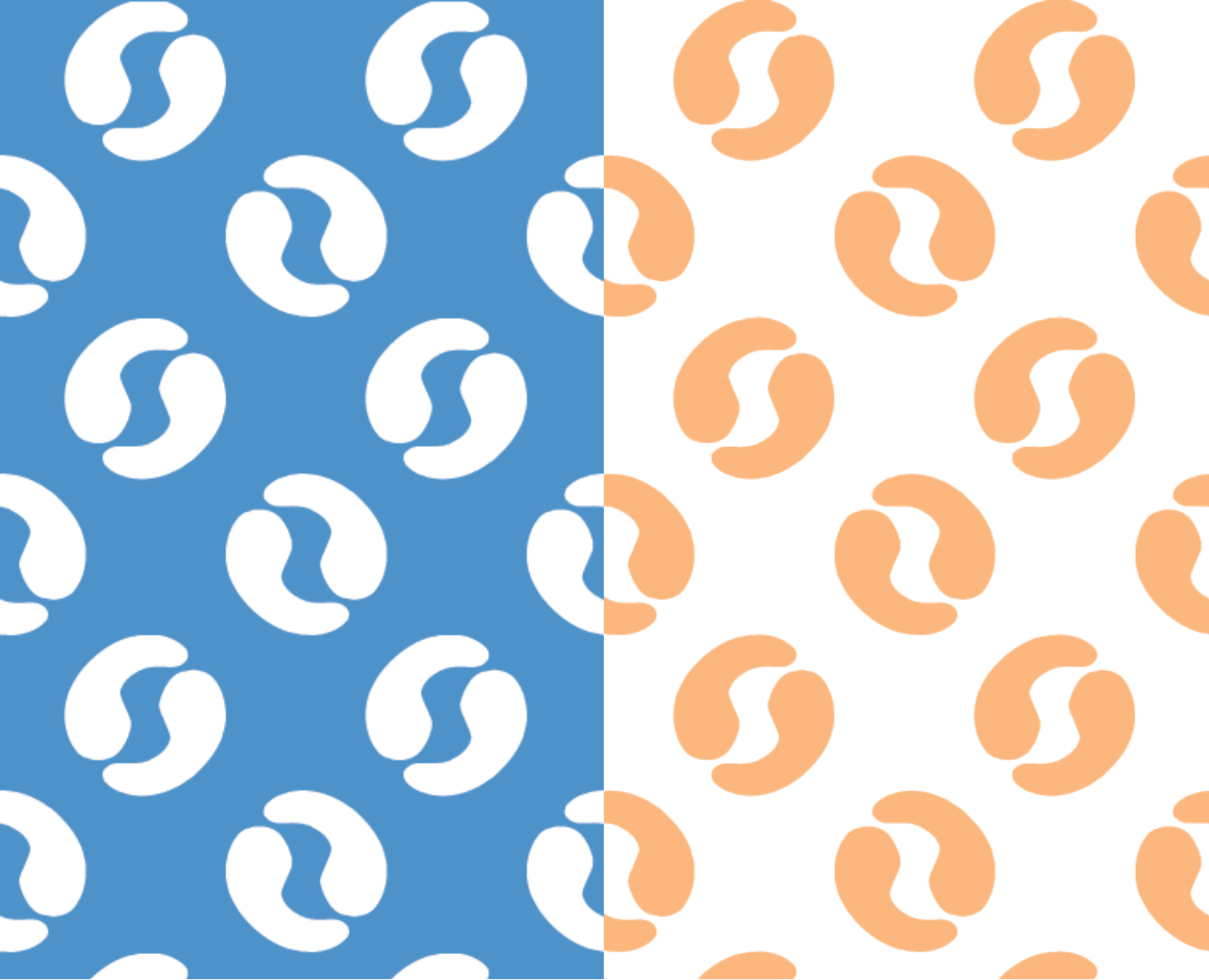


The typical colors of a roscas cookie along with Barugo's seaside charm were incorporated into a cozy yet bright color palette.
